Chronic osteomyelitis & infected joint revision

*Dr E.E.G. Lautenbach, Johannesburg, South Africa
(March / April 1999)*

Dr Charles Lautenbach had an unrivalled international experience in the field of chronic osteomyelitis and revision of infected joint replacement. During his career he managed over 7,000 infected cases, successfully using a suction-irrigation system for antibiotic delivery and lavage. This fellowship allowed extensive exposure to a variety of chronically infected lower limb, upper limb and spinal cases. The aetiology of his patients ranged from post-arthroplasty and trauma, to lower limb infections in diabetics and spina bifida. My time in South Africa allowed me to consolidate the training in chronic osteomyelitis and problem fractures which I had already gained working with Prof. Richardson in Oswestry and Mr Peter Thomas in Stoke-on-Trent. Dr Lautenbach's "hands on" approach to teaching gave me a unique operative experience which continues to influence me in my clinical practice.

Knee arthroplasty & soft tissue surgery

*Dr M.J. Cross, Sydney, Australia
(July 1999–June 2000 - Year 6 Training)*

Dr Cross is regarded as the foremost knee surgeon in Australia and has a thoroughly justified international reputation. His philosophy of knee surgery from "womb to tomb" makes his fellowship a diverse and rewarding surgical experience. Dr Cross' main interests are in primary knee replacement, patello-femoral disease and cruciate ligament reconstruction. In addition to the extensive operative and clinical training, the fellowship also had a large emphasis on research. During my 12 months with Dr Cross I wrote and published 9 research papers, one book chapter and presented at an international meeting. I wrote 6 patient information articles for the clinic web site, which I helped develop during my time in Sydney.

Comment with Hindsight

Undertaking 2 separate International Fellowships during my training has had a direct impact on my clinical and academic work and continues to do so. The 'Lautenbach Principles' that I studied and refined has proved seminal in my management of both Osteomyelitis and Prosthetic Joint Infection. Charles passed away in June 2018 aged 86. He was still working up until his death, but only doing the difficult cases. He had a moto, 'the buck stops here'.

Equally significant were the basics of good clinical practice, operating technique and surgical planning that Dr Mervyn Cross instilled in me. This allows me to deal with a large referral base and the highly complex knee problems that my tertiary clinical practice covers, in both the Welsh and English Health Services and an international Private Practice.

Master's degree in medical science

This degree from the School of Postgraduate Medicine, Keele University was the first of its kind in the UK. The intention was to provide trainees already in career posts with the knowledge and skills, outside that required by their own speciality, necessary to become a Consultant.

There are many and diverse demands placed on Consultant staff in the NHS, including an understanding of management issues, the ability to critically evaluate health care practices and effectively undertake the development of their own careers and that of the staff under their supervision. The master's degree in medical science recognised these demands and addressed them through the various course modules

i.e. Medical Education, Medical Ethics, Health Informatics, Laboratory Medicine, Primary-Secondary Health Care Interfaces, Statistics & Epidemiology, Research Methodology and Health Service Management.

My thesis for the master's degree was an anatomical and histological study of the inter-cruciate ligament of the human knee, a structure not previously identified.
